D. D. D. D. is pleased to present *Justice [laughter] Justice*, a site-specific sculptural installation by Paz Sher. This will be the artist's first solo exhibition in New York City. The opening reception will be on Friday February 27th, 6-8pm.

Sher's installations are carefully crafted environments of unstable playful-mess in which systems of objects and spatial gestures interact in cryptic but realized relationships. These experimental encounters transcend linguistic boundaries in order to undermine and precede our shifting surroundings.

Artist Biography

Paz Sher (b. 1988, Netherlands) is an installation artist and sculptor based in Brooklyn, New York. Sher holds an MFA (2024) from the Sculpture and Extended Media Department at Virginia Commonwealth University, Richmond VA, and a BFA cum laude (2017) from Bezalel Academy of Art and Design, Jerusalem.

Sher has exhibited his work in group shows in Jerusalem, Tel Aviv, Leipzig, Richmond VA, Washington D.C., and New York. He had one collaborative dual show at Atelier Shemi Gallery, and significant solo shows at Hamidrasha Gallery in Tel Aviv (2020) and, as part of his MFA thesis show, at The Anderson Gallery in Richmond, VA.
